

German Township Electric Aggregation Program Update

Due to extended contract negotiations with the new German Township Electric Aggregation Program supplier German Township residents enrolled in the current program will be sent back to utility for generation service for May and June. The new program will start in July.

Residents will receive a notice from the current generation supplier IGS that they are being placed back to the Utility. The new supplier First Energy Solutions will be sending opt-out letters to eligible customers in May. Those who want to participate in the program need to do nothing as they will be automatically included in the program. Those wishing to be excluded will need to opt-out.

Ineligible customers will also be receiving a letter in May instructing them what they need to do if they wish to be included in the German Township Aggregation Program.

The new generation rate is \$.0539 for 36 months. It will begin in July 17 and expire in June 20. There will be no early termination fee if anyone would wish to leave the program at any time during the contract term.
